Organizational Relationships:

Reports to Lead Pastor or his/her designee. Works collaboratively with all Program and Support Staff, and Worship and Music Ministry Team Leaders. Works within the guidelines of the Congregation’s Constitution and By-Laws, personnel policies, and the principles of the Evangelical Covenant Church of America.

Position Overview:

- Responsible for coordinating and organizing all Worship Team activities at Rochester Covenant Church. 15 hours a week.
- Work with pastoral staff and worship planning team (in consultation with organist and choir director) to plan and implement music in weekly worship services.
- Responsible for leading worship on Sunday mornings in conjunction with Worship Team and Pastoral Staff, etc.
- Recruit, prepare, and direct musicians for all Worship Team activities including rehearsals, worship services, special and seasonal services.
- Responsible for maintaining communication with Sound Team, Facility Manager, Media Team, etc. related to rehearsals and services involving Worship Team.
- Establish a good rapport with members of the Worship Team to help each participant use and develop their spiritual gifts and musical talents to the fullest.
- Audition all persons interested in becoming involved with the Worship Team to assure both spiritual and musical appropriateness.
- Support the overall mission and fellowship of Rochester Covenant Church.

Desired Qualifications:

- An individual who professes to be a committed Christian and desires to lead an exemplary Biblical lifestyle.
- Strong musical ability as both guitarist and vocalist preferred.
- Experience leading a band – as instrumentalist and/or vocalist – is desired, but not required.
- Requires strong interpersonal, teamwork, and supervisory skills.
- Able to exercise sound judgment and problem solving skills.
- Demonstrates creativity, is self-motivated, organized, and requires minimal supervision.
- Able to express ideas clearly and concisely, both orally and in writing.
